

Week 1:

Trailblazers: Maps & Missions

Summer kicks off with an exciting exploration theme! Kids become junior cartographers, learning to read maps, follow trails, and design their own expeditions. This week is all about discovery - both of the outdoors and of new friends who'll share the entire summer journey together.



Week 1: Trailblazers – Maps & Missions

Campers will create personalized adventure maps, learn basic navigation skills, and work in teams to complete mapping challenges. They'll discover local trails, hidden treasures in nature, and the joy of exploration that sets the tone for weeks to come.

Field Trip

Local park or greenway for a real mapping adventure where kids apply their new skills

Week 2:

Sky Stories: Wind & Weather

Building on last week's exploration, we turn our eyes upward! This week combines science and creativity as kids investigate the fascinating world above us. From fluffy clouds to powerful winds, children discover how weather works while creating beautiful flying art.



Week 2: Sky Stories – Wind & Weather

What We'll Explore:

- Build and fly homemade kites that really soar
- Create colorful windsocks to visualize wind patterns
- Learn about different cloud types and weather prediction
- Track daily weather and understand forecasting
- Experiment with air pressure and wind power

Field Trip Adventure

Visit a local weather station or host a meteorologist who shares the secrets of weather forecasting

Kids' Weather Forecast Show-campers present their own weather predictions with handmade props and charts



Week 3:

Big Build City

Now that we've mapped the land and explored the sky, it's time to build! This week transforms campers into architects and engineers as they design and construct an entire cityscape.



Week 3: Big Build City

Using recyclables, building blocks, and endless imagination, kids create towers that touch the sky, bridges that span rivers, and tunnels that connect neighborhoods.



Tower Design

Learn about structural stability while building the tallest, strongest towers possible using engineering principles



Bridge Building

Discover how bridges support weight and span distances- then test your designs with exciting challenges



Tunnel Systems

Create underground passages and transportation networks that connect different parts of Kid City



Urban Planning

Collaborate to design parks, roads, and neighborhoods where everyone's ideas come together

Architecture walk through downtown or visit to a hands-on children's museum with building exhibits

Week 4:

Art in Motion

Where Arts meets Movements

This week introduces the magical intersection of creativity and physics! Kids explore kinetic art – sculptures and creations that actually move.

They'll learn how simple machines, gravity, and momentum can transform static art into mesmerizing moving masterpieces.



Week 4: Art in Motion

From marble runs that twist and turn to wind-powered sculptures that dance in the breeze, campers discover that art doesn't have to sit still. Each creation teaches principles of motion while encouraging artistic expression and problem-solving.



Marble Run

Design and build elaborate ramps, tunnels, and loops for marbles to race through



Wind Sculptures

Create art that moves with the breeze using recycled materials and creative designs



Balance Art

Explore gravity and balance with wobbling, spinning, and swinging artistic creations

This week transforms camp into a chemistry playground where kids become color scientists.



Week 5: Color Lab

They'll experiment with natural dyes, create stunning prints, and explore safe kitchen-chemistry reactions that produce amazing visual results. Every activity is a perfect blend of art and science that makes learning feel like magic.



Natural Dye Magic

Extract colors from fruits, vegetables, and plants to create beautiful natural dyes - then dye fabric to take home



Print Techniques

Learn multiple printing methods including block printing, stamp art, and bubble prints for unique masterpieces



Color Reactions

Watch colors transform through safe chemical reactions using household ingredients like baking soda and vinegar

Week 6:

Ocean Odyssey

Dive Into the Deep Blue!

The adventure takes a splash as we explore Earth's magnificent oceans! Kids discover fascinating marine ecosystems, learn about ocean currents and tides, and create underwater-themed art inspired by sea creatures.

This week combines marine biology, environmental awareness, and creative expression as campers become ocean explorers.

Week 9: The Listening Lab

Campers become sound scientists and musicians, creating DIY instruments, mapping soundscapes, and learning the art of truly listening. It's a week that combines music, science, and mindfulness in creative and memorable ways.

Instrument Building

Create shakers, drums, pan flutes, and string instruments from recycled materials- then learn to play them!

Sound Mapping

Explore different environments and create visual maps of the sounds we hear- from birds to traffic to whispers

Rhythm Games

Play echo games, create group rhythms, and discover how timing and tempo make music magical

Professional drum circle leader or sound recording booth visit - kids experience making music together and may record their creations

Mini Sound Concert and Gallery - campers perform on their handmade instruments while families explore sound map displays

The summer adventure culminates with the most important mission: becoming Eco-Heroes! This final week wraps up the entire journey as kids apply everything they've learned to environmental stewardship and green innovation.
